Call Scripts for Oposing Proposed Elimination of the 30% Residential Solar Tax Credit (Section 25D).

Bill Summary

The "Ending Intermittent Energy Subsidies Act of 2025" proposes a full phase-out of all federal clean electricity tax credits (Sections 45Y and 48E) for solar and wind energy. Over four years, these credits would be reduced from 100% to 0%. The bill also eliminates the ability to transfer these credits, a key financing mechanism for projects. If passed, it would dramatically reduce financial incentives for renewable energy, disrupt project financing, and potentially shrink the solar and wind industries across the country.

Target Audience

- Homeowners who installed or plan to install solar
- Renewable energy industry workers
- Clean energy investors
- Climate and environmental activists
- Voters in states with large solar/wind potential (e.g., Arizona, Texas, California, Iowa)

Call Script 1: Focus on Economic Impact

Talking Points:

- The bill will gut investment and job growth in America's fastest-growing energy sectors.
- Arizona's solar industry supports thousands of middle-class jobs—this bill puts them at risk.
- Rather than cutting support, we should expand incentives to modernize our grid and build energy independence.

Call Script:

Call Script 2: Focus on Environmental Impact

Talking Points:

- The bill would drastically slow down progress on reducing carbon emissions.
- Arizona faces extreme heat, drought, and wildfires made worse by climate change—solar helps fight that.
- Cutting clean energy support puts polluters back in control of our power.

Call Script:

"Hi, I'm [Your Name] from [Your City/Town], and I'm urging the Representative to vote against the Ending Intermittent Energy Subsidies Act of 2025. This bill undermines our fight against climate change by stripping away critical support for solar and wind energy. Call Script 3: Focus on National Security & Grid Resilience

Talking Points:

- Renewables reduce our reliance on foreign oil and centralized fossil infrastructure.
- The bill undermines grid decentralization, resilience, and backup power solutions.
- Solar and wind are key to energy independence and disaster preparedness.

Call Script:

"Hello, this is [Your Name] calling from [Your City/Town]. I'm calling to oppose the Ending Intermittent Energy Subsidies Act of 2025. This bill weakens America's energy security by undercutting solar and wind power—our best defenses against volatile energy markets and disasters. Distributed solar reduces blackout risks, increases resilience, and gives families control. Taking away these credits puts all of us at greater risk. Please stand up for energy independence and vote NO. Thank you."

Additional Tips for Activists

- **Be polite and confident**—staffers will note tone as well as message.
- Mention you're a voter in their district.
- Share a personal connection to solar/wind if possible.
- Ask for their stance: "Will the Representative vote against this bill?"
- Follow up with an email or tag them on social media.
- Encourage 3 friends to call—volume matters.
